Worship and Sunday School Schedule

An “Early Service” is held at 8:15 a.m. in the Sanctuary

“The Well,” a contemporary Worship Service starts at 9 a.m. in the Family Life Center

Sunday School Classes for elementary-age through adult are held from 9:45 - 10:45 a.m.

Our main Worship Service begins at 11 a.m. in the Sanctuary

Additional services that are offered:

- Childcare for children 2-years-old and younger is provided in the Nursery (Room E-14 of the Education Building) during the 11 a.m. Worship Service.
- Children’s Worship Bulletins (for ages 3-6 and 7-12) and activity bags are available from the Ushers. In addition, “A Time With Young Disciples” is offered as part of the 11 a.m. Worship Service during which all children from 3-years-old through first grade are invited to the front of the Sanctuary to hear the Children’s Sermon.
- A Nursery Supervisor (who is a member of the Hopewell Church Staff) oversees the Nursery area, which is led by two adult volunteers.
- “Safe Sanctuary” Guidelines are followed for all of our Children and Youth programs and activities.
- Hopewell is a wheelchair accessible campus.
- Large-print bulletins (which include a large-print copy of each of the hymns used in the Worship Service) are available from the Ushers at the 8:15 and 11 a.m. Services.
- Assisted hearing devices are offered at the 8:15 and 11 a.m. Worship Services. These are also obtained from the Ushers.
- Hopewell is a “smoke-free” campus.
- Hopewell Presbyterian Church is a member of The Presbytery of Charlotte, which is a part of The Presbyterian Church (USA).

Frequently asked questions:

- **What is the Worship Service like?**
The 8:15 and 11 a.m. Sunday services are “traditional” while the 9 a.m. Service offers a more contemporary style.
- **What do I wear?**
A variety of clothing is acceptable from full “Sunday” dress to more casual attire.
- **Where are Sunday School Classes held?**
Classes are held in each of our three main buildings (follow the link above to the campus map). Someone is usually available under the Breezeway (between the Administrative and Education Buildings) to provide assistance.
- **Where do I take my children?**
The Children’s Sunday School Classes are all located in the Education Building (follow the link above to the campus map).
- **Where do I park?**
There are two entrances to the campus from the Beatties Ford Road. Both lead to ample parking lots.
